Minister's Message

At the heart of Peterborough Cathedral, suspended from the centre of the Nave, is a beautiful 15ft tall crucifix, featuring the body of Christ against a red cross. Beneath it are these words in Latin:

Stat crux dum volvitur orbis.
The cross stands while the world turns.

Our world is in very uncertain, unstable times at the moment. Many are suffering globally: in the Middle East, in Ukraine and in countless other places. Individually, we may have fears about our health, financial circumstances and futures. Take a moment to meditate on those words: The cross stands while the world turns.



The image of the crucified Christ reminds us that whilst God does not purpose our suffering, He has and does enter into it in the person of the Son, Jesus the Christ. He identifies with us and knows exactly what we are going through, even when we don't. He knows us better than we know ourselves. By the cross, He forgives the sin of humanity: my sin and your sin. By the cross, He brings healing to every disease and conquers every evil. Of course, not everything we go through will be overcome in the way we would want, something that I have been contemplating following my recent diagnosis and operation. Yet it will be overcome. The Crucified Christ of Good Friday is now the Risen Christ of Easter Sunday – of every Sunday! And we can sing:

*'Thine be the glory,
risen conquering Son,
endless is the victory
Thou o'er death hast won.'*

May you know the victorious Lord in your life this Easter, and always!
